



Vehicle Theft

Safeguard your automobile

Vehicles are stolen for a variety of reasons, including theft for parts, insurance fraud, re-tagging, exporting, joy riding and many other reasons. Help prevent theft and damage to your vehicle by following some simple steps.



Report It.

Call 911, flag down an officer, or use an emergency call box immediately if your vehicle is stolen, or if you discover other damage/theft.



Lock

Always lock and secure your vehicle. Always activate your alarm every time you leave your vehicle. Consider locking lug nuts to deter wheel theft.



Keys

Never leave the keys in the ignition when you exit the vehicle -- even for a minute!



Property

Never leave property in your vehicle. Items such as loose change, shopping bags, GPS, luggage, cell phones, laptops, tablets, and even charging cords are targeted by thieves.



Parking

Park in high traffic or well lit areas, when possible.



Enroll
